Ramblings for Reflection:

The original meaning of vanity was empty or without any value. Mirrors can now breathe a sigh of relief!! As our concern for creation and the climate heightens, Jesus talks to us about land, the earth, our Mother. A family dispute about land asks the question, can we really own the land that feeds and nurtures us, keeps us alive and protects us if we don't abuse it?? In the story about the rich man, Jesus does not speak about his riches being the problem. The man of the story foolishly thought he owned the gifts that the land offered him when the gifts of the earth are to be shared, as are all gifts. Most people know that you cannot own LOVE. You can show love and you can receive love but love cannot be owned. Love is fluid, has to be lived with reverence and with deep, deep respect.
