Ramblings for Reflection:

FAITH is a little bit like AIR we can break it down into its constituent parts and understand it but it is so much more than that because we can't live without it! This week the focus is more on the element of TRUST which is always supported by its two henchmen or henchwomen: Love and Hope. Every stage and every moment of our lives is dependent on and moulded by trust. We are given the supreme example of trust in Abraham our forefather. But, for a moment, let us pause and reflect on how much God TRUSTS US! God chose us to be members of his family, missionaries of his love and goodness, healing and forgiveness, joy and compassion. Despite the times we get it wrong, follow deviations, even turn against God, God continues to place his full trust in us. God believes in our ability to reach our full potential: to make God's name known and loved. And we do this, not because we might be punished if we don't but of out of immense gratitude, in response to the love received and because our trust finds its
