WELCOME AND PROCLAIM THE GOSPEL

Say/sing together:

Alleluia, alleluia! Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. Alleluia, alleluia! Today some of the words of the Gospel will be left out deliberately; listen carefully and fill them in.

The words to be omitted during the proclamation are presented in brackets.

DISCUSSION

What does John call himself?

- a witness
- a person who sees something.

What . . . Who did John see? - Jesus.

What did John believe?

- Jesus is the Chosen One of God.

How can we be a witness for Jesus? How can we show we believe? - children give examples.

What came from heaven and rested on Jesus?

- the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove.


