- > Several card sets of the individual words of the theme: 'HOW'; 'TO'; 'BE'; 'HAPPY'.

WELCOME AND PROCLAIM THE GOSPEL

Say/sing together:

Alleluia, alleluia! Father, let your face shine on us. Keep us in your love. Alleluia! A reading from the Good News given to us by Matthew. Glory to you, Lord.

When Jesus saw the crowds, he climbed a little hill, where he sat down.


His friends joined him, and he began to tell the people how to be happy:

Happiness is wanting God in your


Happiness is longing for what is right.
