## **Ramblings for Reflection:**

Wisdom is hard to explain without mentioning understanding, knowledge and making choices; three other gifts of the Holy Spirit. But Wisdom is not knowledge or understanding, nor is it our choices or judgements, although it involves them all. So, what is wisdom? How to explain this gift for which we all yearn? Simply, wisdom brings together knowledge, understanding, choices and decision-making in such a way as to see beyond the mix to something deeper. Wisdom is aware of what is unsaid, unknown even unrealised and makes a choice that enriches all who are present to it. In other words, wisdom helps us see reality and unreality as God sees them and enables us to act on that vision in a way that highlights, sanctifies and enhances the value of everything that it touches for it reveals the presence of God, the sacredness of things, of people. In some famous Art Gallery lies a completely black painting. Underneath is written "A black cat in a coal cellar that has no windows and whose door is shut." Wisdom is aware of the black cat! Good paintings like good stories always hold a deeper message than the sum or position of the colours and elements portrayed within it. Wisdom recognises the significance of that hidden message which is always more than what we see, read or hear. Wikipedia adds experience, common sense and insight to Wisdom. ### **AMORIS LAETITIA - THE JOY OF LOVE 19**

The experiences and challenges of families today "Today encounter we widespread uncertainty and ambiguity. For example, we rightly value a personalism that opts for authenticity as



opposed to mere conformity. While this can favour spontaneity and a better use of people's talents, if misdirected, it can foster attitudes of constant suspicion, fear of commitment, self centeredness and arrogance."

"Freedom of choice makes it possible to plan our lives and to make the most of ourselves. Yet this freedom requires noble goals and personal discipline in order to develop the ability to give oneself generously to others. Indeed in many countries where the number of marriages is decreasing, more and more people are choosing to live alone or simply to spend time together cohabiting."

"We point to a praiseworthy concern for justice; but if misunderstood, this can turn citizens into clients interested solely in the provision of services."
