- > Pictures of Jesus.
- > Birthday cake and birthday cards.
- > Seven candles.
- > Seven gift-wrapped packages; inside, cards marked with one of the gifts of the Spirit (joy; love; patience; kindness; understanding; reverence; courage).
- > Dove or flame shape cut-outs.

WELCOME AND PROCLAIM THE WORD OF THE LORD

Say/sing together:

Alleluia, alleluia! Come, Holy Spirit, fill our hearts with the fire of your love. Alleluia! A reading from the Story of the Early Church given to us by Luke.

DISCUSSION

Recall with the children that before he returned to his Father, Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit gives us the gifts we need to carry on Jesus' work, the gifts we need to be like Jesus.

Open the gift packets, and take out the 'gifts' printed on the cards. Together, talk of examples of people who use one or more of these gifts.
