# Ramblings for Reflection:

Transfiguration reveals the hidden presence and glory of God. It can be found in the smile of a baby, the appearance of the sun on a dull, grey day, in the deep experience of love, in a piece of music or a painting. They are moments when we see far beyond the visual image. Mother Teresa was certainly no pinup but her life and her work showed itself on her face as someone beautifully filled with the presence of God, a presence that was tangible. Jesus revealed his true presence to his disciples in order to support and sustain them through his passion and death and help them understand the resurrection more clearly. There are many moments in life when we hear, see or experience something of another person, someone close to us, that transforms our understanding and perception of them. Ever after, we see them in a new light and our relationship to them is changed, deepened and enriched. Together we make up the Body of Christ and it is Christ's presence that transforms us. Moments of transfiguration reveal to us his presence and in the experience of that presence and love we, too, are transfigured. And, if we take time to listen, we will hear the Father say to us, "You, too, are my beloved and my favour rests on vou!"
