Ramblings for Reflection:

Sr Macrina Wiederkehr OSB wrote, "You are a creature of wonder. You are a poet. You are a poet not because of what you write but because of how you see." What do you see in the readings this week? An episode full of drama, Jesus master of nature, the power of the sea, faith lived, faith doubted. After a period of prayer, Jesus wanted to re-join his friends and probably started walking across the water without realising it?? In all the excitement and wonder, Peter wants to go to meet Jesus but, as we read, he is beleaquered with doubts once on the water. How true to life this is when we face troubles of our own or when others face hard times, difficulties, health problems, we automatically want to reach out and help, not always knowing what to do for the best. Yet we reach out and people are grateful for our support, we even find we do things we thought impossible and discover something new about ourselves even if the discovery was that our doubts were unfounded. In reaching out, Jesus discovered his power over nature, all because of his friendship and concern for Peter. This deepened Jesus understanding of the value of friendship and its importance and encouraged him to ask us to care for our neighbour and those in need. When we do this, we will better understand our friendships, especially our friendship with Jesus.
