Seeing things in their true richness, depth and wonder, is a breath-taking experience. An experience that is hard to put into words and yet something we want to hang on to but can't. No wonder Peter wanted to build three tents, he wanted to hang on to his breath-taking revelation of Jesus, who wouldn't? Although the Transfiguration took place well on in Jesus' ministry, it is an experience possible for us during our Lenten Journey. Lent offers us an opportunity to see Jesus' presence in our lives, in our world, in others. in a completely new way. The story also reminds us that we are the beloved children of God and the importance of listening. Listening to God can be inspiring, challenging, fill us with hope as well as trepidation, encourage us and open us to our failures as well as to how God is working in and through us. It can help us see that our failures can be a blessing because they help us realise our need of God in our lives. In the twelve step programme, people own their failures; not as something to be celebrated but in order not to let the failure dictate the way they live their life. Like all of us, they recognise the need of a power greater than themselves, a power we find in Jesus, in God, and accessed through the community.
