Due to the installation of the new organ shortly, part of the Church (around the organ and by the library) will be closed off from Tuesday afternoon (26 June) until Thursday afternoon (28 June). There will be a second collection next weekend (30th June/1st July) in aid of Peter's Pence. At the end of the 8th century, the Anglo-Saxons, after their conversion, felt so attached to the Bishop of Rome, they decided to stably send an annual contribution to the Holy Father. Thus was born the "Denarius Sancti Petri" (Alms to Saint Peter), which soon spread throughout Europe. This, like other similar practices, passed through many ups and downs over the centuries, until it was blessed by Pope Pius IX, with the Saepe venerabilis Encyclical of 5 August 1871. Currently, this collection takes place throughout the Catholic world, mostly on 29 June or on the Sunday closest to the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul.
