

# Ramblings for Reflection:

How often do we create images of people and fail to see beyond the image. Often the image we create supports our belief about them. For someone we like, we focus on their good qualities and discount any negativity as unimportant. For someone we don't like or who threatens our security or tranquility, we find the negative elements about them to support our belief. More often than not, this is because of fear. A fear based on ignorance, that makes us feel vulnerable and out of our depth. In his wisdom, St Paul says that this fear and vulnerability is precisely the way in which God wants to work in and through us. The Gospel suggests we are not asked to do the impossible - even Jesus could not help people who were closed to him. Jesus was rejected not because of who he was but because he did not fit the people's image of who he should be. For too long, we have been misinformed, negatively, about lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender people. They are too easily rejected, just like Jesus, either because of this negative image or because they do not fit our image of who is acceptable. If his own people had spent more time discovering who Jesus truly was, their lives would have been enriched and changed for the better. We, too, will be enriched and our lives changed if we spend time discovering who people truly are, whatever their gender, especially those we believe do not fit!
