Ramblings for Reflection:

References to the importance and value of bread abound. "Bread is the king of the table and all else is merely the court that surrounds the king. The countries are the soup, the meat, the vegetables, the salad, but bread is king." (Louis Bromfield). "The bread that you store up belongs to the hungry; the coat that lies in your chest belongs to the naked; the gold that you have hidden in the ground belongs to the poor." - St. Basil. With a piece of bread in your hand, you will find paradise under a pine tree. (Russian Proverb). Rather a piece of bread with a happy heart than wealth with grief. (Egyptian Proverb). Better dry bread in peacetime than meat in wartime. - Hungarian Proverb. We call Bread "the staff of life!" By calling himself the Bread of Life, Jesus enriched the meaning and understanding of the phrase. Some food we eat is special, not just because of its taste but because of who made it. Mum's apple pie always tastes better that anyone else's and when we do not have it, we yearn for a slice. What is also true is that it does not taste the same, unless she is present. Jesus is always present in the bread we receive at the Eucharist (no matter who gives it to us) but it will not taste the same or nourish us in the same way unless we are aware of Jesus' presence? *****
