Ramblings for Reflection: "Follow Christ, loving as he loved you . . ." The belief in the 'Real Presence' of Christ in the Eucharist both feeds, challenges, motivates and inspires us to love as Christ loves us. As bread, Jesus is alive, and, in receiving the Eucharist (and even if we don't) Christ is present in us. In fact, Christ is present in every encounter whether it be with a person or creation. Following Christ, then, is a lived experience, a lived relationship. However, too often, we fail to recognise this presence of Christ in our encounters and we miss out. Think of the words "I Love you!" The phrase allows for many different interpretations. Sometimes it just means I like you, but could mean I really like you. It could mean you are an important or the most important person in my life. It can express the deepest form of love for another person, wanting only the best for them and their happiness - many different levels of understanding. When we recognise that Jesus is present in all levels of love, we discover that his presence adds something more profound and them. In the Transfiguration, celebrated last Monday, Jesus reveals himself as he really is, in his transcendence and his divinity. taking us to a new and deeper level of understanding. We are taken beyond the physical. Loving as Jesus loves leads us into living in the eternal, in the transcendent, in the spiritual and in the divine. Who wouldn't want to follow Christ? **ተ**ተተተተተተተ

Bedford Road roundabout: 23 - 25 August, carriageway reconstruction 8pm - 5am. Nightingale Road roundabout: 28 - 31 August, carriageway reconstruction 8pm - 5am. The works will be completed using road closures, with a fully signed diversion route.
