


A message from Fr Michael Francis Lambert aa

Fr Michael will be buried at St John's Cemetery at 1pm All are welcome to attend and return to the reception



Walking/driving directions:

- Left out of the church car park and left into Ickleford Rd
- · Left at mini-roundabout into Nightingale Rd and past church
- Right at the 2nd mini-roundabout onto Verulam Rd
- · Continue straight ahead at the next roundabout up Highbury Rd
- · At the end of Highbury Road, turn left onto Whitehill Rd
- · Take the next right into St John's Rd
- The entrance to the cemetery is off of Cemetery Rd, which is on the right opposite the community centre

Please note parking is very limited in the cemetery but you may find space in surrounding streets.
