Ramblings for Reflection

Why do we use the language of war when speaking about our enemies? Jesus doesn't! Love your enemies! If they take something from you, give them something else! Turn the other cheek! This is quite the opposite. Being compassionate implies that Jesus doesn't ask us to overcome our enemies but convert them. Don't you think that God would rather convert Satan than defeat him? (Sorry Archangel Michael!) Jesus suggests that we shower an enemy with kindness, goodness, and love, so as to win their friendship. Oscar Wilde said, Always forgive your enemies - nothing annoys them so much! Pope Francis says: "This Gospel presents us with one of the hallmarks of Jesus' message. . . . My enemy is someone I must love. In God's heart there are no enemies. God only has sons and daughters. We are the ones who raise walls, build barriers and label people. God has sons and daughters, precisely so that no one will be turned away. God's love includes everybody. It is a parental love that never abandons us, even when we go astray. Our Father does not wait for us to be good before he loves us. He does not wait for us to be a little bit better or more perfect before he loves us; he loves us because he chose to love us, he loves us because he has made us his sons and daughters. He loved us even when we were enemies. No matter how sullied our hands may be, God will continue to place in them the Life he wishes to bestow on us. We must do the same!
