Ramblings for Reflection Reflecting on the Spirit of God is a little like reflecting on a beautiful landscape or sunset, or, one of those moments when you feel truly grateful for being alive. To localise the Spirit we have the images of a dove. of the wind and fire, suggesting movement, life, energy, and power. We speak of the gifts and fruits of the Spirit and particularly today of wonder and awe. The longer the reflection, the greater the realisation that wherever we look, however we feel, we are aware of the presence of God's Spirit. Even in those difficult and dark times, we search for the presence of that Spirit, seemingly missing. We are like the little fish who swims around the ocean asking the question, "Where is the Ocean?" The Spirit of God is so present we are fully immersed in that presence. We breathe in the Spirit of God in the very air we breathe. St Augustine of Hippo spoke of the Spirit of God as "Ever ancient, ever new!" When coming to prayer and meditation we are often told to centre ourselves, to calm ourselves and begin by focusing on our breathing. Every breath we take carries within us the presence of God. As we realise that, we gradually become aware of the presence of the Spirit in anything and everything that we encounter and that passes through our minds, even in those times we are distracted. The Spirit is everywhere. And, far from feeling overcome with that all pervading presence, we feel FREE!!
