# Ramblings for Reflection

We have great difficulty listening to stories because we want to analyse them, look for hidden information about the context and background and dream up all kinds of questions. A story is a story, is a story with its own wonder and a vehicle for treasures only discovered by entering into it and letting it transport you into a new vision. Our three stories concern Peter, Paul and Jesus missioning Peter. These two saints are all about mission and how they responded to their call with trust in Jesus and total commitment. Despite their failings, Jesus helped them through impossible situations so that they could fulfil their mission. Like Peter and Paul, we, too, are given a mission and asked to be part of the rock on which the Church is built. No one can fulfil our mission but us. We might not relate to Peter's escape from jail because we do not believe in angels, not having ever encountered a being with wings, and yet we are quite willing to talk about experiencing the presence of God. Anything that points us to God's presence is an angel - wings or not. There are angels all around us! Today's feast reassures us that, like Peter and Paul, we will fulfil our mission to bring good news to the world if we but place our hope, trust and love in the Lord. After all, Jesus places his hope, trust and love in us - in YOU and in me - just as he did in Peter and Paul. **++++++++++**
