

# Ramblings

Amen.

The Holy Spirit always appears when something of great important is about to happen. The Holy Spirit was present at the beginning of Jesus life the annunciation. The Spirit is present at Jesus' Baptism, marking the start of something very special confirmed by the Voice from Heaven. Isaiah explains that Jesus, the Messiah, comes to establish true Justice; not just an external Justice in and between all nations but a justice within ourselves. A justice that restores balance and harmony to life: sight to the blind, freedom to captives, hearing to the deaf; enabling the lame to walk, the dumb to speak, forgiveness and healing for the sinner. Evil seeks to overpower, enslave, incarcerate and separate us one from another, creating a loneliness that suffocates life and leads to utter despair. The harmony and balance Jesus offers are both physical and spiritual. We become not just friends but family with Jesus who creates community in which everyone is special and unique, no-one is better than anyone else nor wants to be. A community in which each one complements the others to create ever greater harmony and balance. Benedict XVI on Augustine: "The harmony between faith and reason, means above all that God is not remote; he is not far from our reason and life; he is close to every human being, close to our hearts and to our reason, if we truly set out on the journey." Pope Francis: Happiness can only be discovered as a gift of harmony between the whole and each single component. Even science points to an understanding of reality as a place where every element connects and interacts with everything else.
