Ramblings

A star led the Magi to Jesus who was himself the light. Jesus begins his ministry as the light promised by God to lead not only his people but all peoples to salvation. Simeon proclaimed him the light of the nations while holding him. For Simeon to know that this particular baby was Jesus, a light must have shone out of him as he was being offered to God. Jesus' presentation heralded the time when he would offer himself to the Father totally on the Cross. Not only did he prove the prophecies true but also that God fulfils his promises. In doing so he gave them much greater meaning; showing his complete love for the Father and his complete love for us. Not wanting one of us to be lost, it is no wonder that St Paul wrote: "It was essential that (Jesus) became completely like us so that he could be a compassionate and trustworthy high priest, able to atone for our sins. It is because he has been through temptation that he is able to help others who are tempted." Pope Francis rightly calls this day a day of encounter: "What does this mean for us?" He asks, "We, too, are called to welcome Jesus who comes to meet us. To encounter him - the God of life – means encountering him every day of our lives; not now and then, but every day. To follow Jesus is not a decision taken once and for all, it is a daily choice. And we do not meet the Lord virtually, but directly, we encounter him in our lives, in the concreteness of life." And, at each encounter, his light grows stronger within us.
