VISUAL AIDS

- > Mountain scenes.
- > Twigs bursting into bud.
- > Cloud shape cut-outs.

WELCOME AND PROCLAIM THE GOSPEL

Say/sing together:

Praise to you, O Christ, our Saviour. This is my beloved son. Listen to him. Praise to you, O Christ, our Saviour. A reading from the Good News given to us by Matthew, Mark and Luke.

Glory to you, Lord.

Jesus took with him Peter, James and John, and led them up a high mountain to pray.
As Jesus prayed, he changed.
His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as brilliant as lightning.

DISCUSSION

Where did Jesus go to pray?
Who did he take with him?
What happened?
Who appeared with Jesus?
Why did the cloud come?
- as a sign of God's presence.

The world is full of signs of God's presence; have the children give examples.

Above all, God has given us Jesus as a special sign of his presence.

What did the voice from the cloud say?
How can we listen to Jesus in the

coming week?


YEARS A, B, C 2nd SUNDAY OF LENT

SHARING

Encourage the children to talk about how the world is changed by sunlight.

Twigs that look dead sprout buds. Flowers open.

Have the children give examples. Everything comes alive in the warmth of spring.



Suddenly, Moses and Elijah appeared, talking to him. Peter said, Lord, it's good that we are here. Let us make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah.'

As he spoke, a bright cloud came and covered them with its shadow, and from the cloud came a voice which said,
