Ramblings St Paul writes to the Ephesians (and to us): May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, give you a spirit of wisdom and perception of what is revealed, to bring you to full knowledge of him. May he enlighten the eyes of your mind so that you can see what hope his call holds for you, what rich glories he has promised the saints will inherit. Wisdom: what is it? Wisdom provides us with discernment in all our decision making. It leads us to a knowledge and understanding of God's will. It is entirely God given. "The fear (deep reverence and veneration) of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; all those who practice it have a good understanding!" (Psalm 111:10) Wisdom opens us to and gives us access to the Truth, to Jesus Christ, to the Word of God. It opens our lives to the power of the Holy Spirit - the Spirit of God who develops in us the mind of Christ. The gift of wisdom perfects in us the virtue of charity. Wisdom empowers us "to judge and order all things in accordance with divine norms that flows from a loving union with God and unites us to the heart of Jesus." It helps us recognize the gifts God has given us through the Holy Spirit. The birth of Christ, the light, opens us to the gift of wisdom with which we have been blessed. It gives us the ability to recognise God's presence in the smallest as well as the greatest moments of our lives. May this most precious gift of Wisdom guide and encourage us throughout We will never fully understand,

no matter how much we try, God's ways are outside our realm, along with the reasons 'why'. We analyse and intellectualise what we do not understand, we need God's wisdom in our hearts. not the intellect of man.

I wonder how almighty God,

all knowing and divine, how He could care about my world and give undivided time. But this is the complexity of the holy, great 'I Am', we often do not fully grasp and we fail to understand. 
