Ramblings The God of Glory (Ephesians 1:3-14) How blessed is God! And what a blessing God is! God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, offers us blessings in all sorts of ways. Long before he laid down earth's foundations, he had us in mind, chose us to be the focus of his love, desired us to be made whole and holy through his love. Long, long ago he adopted us into his family through Jesus Christ. (What pleasure he took in planning this!) He wanted us to enter into the celebration of his lavish gift-giving through the loving hands of his beloved Son.

Because of the sacrifice of Jesus pouring out his blood on the altar of the Cross, we are all free free of penalties and punishments chalked up by all our misdeeds. And not just barely free, either, but abundantly free! He thought of everything and provided for everything we could possibly need. He let us in on the plans that he took such delight in making. He set it all out before us in Christ; a long-range plan in which everything would be brought together and summed up in him, everything in the heavens, everything on the earth.

It is in Christ that we discover who we are and why we are here. Long before we ever heard of Christ, God had his eye on us, had designs on us for glorious living, part of the overall purpose being fulfilled in everything and everyone.

It is in Christ that, once you heard the truth and believed it (the Message of our salvation), you found yourselves home free — signed, sealed, and delivered by the Holy Spirit. This down payment from God is the first instalment on what is coming, a reminder that we will receive everything God has planned for us - a life that offers praise and glory to God.
