Reflect again on St Paul's words to the Colossians:

We are God's chosen race, his saints; he loves us, and he wants to clothe us in sincere compassion, in kindness and humility, gentleness and patience. God asks us to be open and welcoming towards each other and non-judgemental. In other words, bear with one another and forgive one another as soon as a quarrel or disagreement begins.
