## **Reflection Monday Week 3 St Francis de Sales 2022**

**St Francis de Sales** (1567 - 1622) was born near Annecy, in Savoy, studied law and was ordained a priest despite opposition from his father. His first mission was re-evangelizing the local people (the Chablais), who had become Calvinists. Despite hostility, he preached with such effectiveness that in four years most had returned to the Church. Appointed bishop of Geneva, he began reforming and reorganising the diocese, and caring for people through preaching and spiritual guidance. St Francis taught that everyone can achieve a devout and spiritual life: holiness is not reserved to monks and hermits alone. He wrote *"religious devotion does not destroy: it perfects,"* and dedicated himself to making people more holy by helping them make more of themselves. Motivated and inspired by Christ's love, he said *"whoever wants to preach effectively must preach with love."*
