Reflection Wednesday 3rd Week Lent 2022

Since law is often linked with punishment, it is often viewed with dislike and even dread. Law enforcers who have abused the punishment imposed and created a terror of the Law have not helped. But the Law that Moses and Jesus talk about is a Law that offers a life full of wisdom and prudence. In other words, the real intention of Law is to help and guide us into making wise and healthy decisions for the good of the whole community. It reminds us that we live in a large family that Christians call the *Kingdom of God*.

Law promotes good-will and compassion, encourages common sense and helps create a welcoming community. A community in which everyone has a place and is enabled to make a unique contribution for the good of all. Moses stated and Jesus showed that God is very, very close to this family. Present in everything, God makes all things, including us, holy and alive with his grace, goodness and love.

As members of this family, like Macrina Wiederkehr we would want to pray: -

O Holy Spirit, come. Come with your transforming power. Breathe upon and into my thoughts and actions this day. Let my work be a labour of love.
