After the crucifixion all who knew Jesus would have asked themselves why this happened, how could it have happened. They would have felt guilty for letting Jesus down or not doing enough along with the many *if onlys* that follow any kind of tragedy. The inward focusing can become almost suffocating as seen in Mary Magdalen when she found the empty tomb.

The vacated tomb was much more than empty, it spelt desolation, made no sense, was vacuous, devoid of meaning. Maybe we need to enter into that state of utter degradation to be able to welcome a risen Lord.

To have everything turned around in the blink of an eye is beyond anything words can hope to describe. The real Joy of Easter, isn't how we feel or what we experience, however uplifting and exhilarating, but that Jesus is alive, Jesus is risen! All that brutal and inhuman suffering, all that pain, betrayal and denial, all the periods of hopelessness and being forsaken, have become the very soil of New Life - Risen Life.
