Reflection Saturday 3rd Week Easter 2022

All stories, however factual, offer us many rich reflections. The raising of Tabitha from death puts Peter on a par with Jesus only Peter raised Tabitha to life in the name of Jesus. But this story also speaks to us of the life that Jesus offers in welcoming his name into our lives. Whatever is dead or decayed will be cast away at the sound of Jesus' name and the new life wants to be lived to be fully appreciated. In living and sharing the Good News with others, we can bring people, who have never welcomed Jesus before, to new life. It will be the same as raising them from the dead!!
