Parish Finances

The Parish Accounts continue to show an operating deficit now running at £12,468 for the year through to the end of May.

However, with the re-introduction of taking a Collection at Mass, there has been a slight improvement in Offertory income and there are also signs of an increased interest in hall rentals although, at the moment, these are mainly "one-offs".

The anticipated increase in gas and electricity charges will put further pressure of the Parish finances but the tax rebate on Gift Aided donations (see below) will help towards balancing the books.

Gift Aid Claim

The Gift Aid tax rebate claim for the 2021/2022 Tax Year has been completed, signed-off by Fr Tom and passed to the Diocese for approval and submission to HMRC. It will realise just over £23K. This is down on normal but has held up remarkably well considering that income is still well down on pre-Pandemic levels

Christopher House

Terms and conditions for the Order's continued use of Christopher House have been agreed with Fr Tom and an updated Tenancy Agreement has been sent to the Property Dept at the Diocese for approval.

Parish Audit

The date for the Parish Audit has now been set. It will take place on 10 and 11 August 2022.

 - Monthly meet up at the Orange Tree on a Sunday evening all nonalcoholic drinks are free
 - 4. Hitchin Pantry offers their service free to all Ukrainian families
 - 5. Universal Credit applications are treated favourably
 - 6. Leave to stay applications for 3 years are treated favourably
 - 7. NHS is being very supportive
 - 8. Schools are also being supportive and there is funding for education places
 - 9. Bim Afolami organised an event where guests could meet people from education, the council and prospective employers
 - 10. Some are attending local churches

- Hosted CTH sharing meeting using questions from Synodal process.
- We have had Masses at Milford Lodge and Elmside and hope to continue monthly again now.
- Support and transport to a number of parishioners with hospital appointments
- Support to the Skeet family following the death of Mary

- Rehearsals and delivery of 6 performances of Life of Christ at Wintershall to approx. 5000 people.

- Support Catholic Listeners service out of Landings which was launched at Easter. Initial results published in newsletter.
