Prayer for Ukraine: God of peace and justice, we pray for the people of Ukraine; for peace and the laying down of weapons. Give comfort to those who fear for tomorrow. Grant wisdom, discernment and compassion to guide those who have power over war and peace. Hold and protect your precious children, at risk and in fear. We pray in the name of Jesus, Prince of Peace, Amen.

Ramblings This week's question (which we ask many times in our lives) is where and how will we meet Jesus having celebrated with great joy his resurrection? In fact, we may turn away from Jesus, give up, seek other avenues of life but Jesus never gives up on us, never stops trying to find ways to meet us, on whatever road we might be traveling. He will not give up until we recognise his presence. Jesus' presence is recognised and experienced by many in the eucharist but we can also encounter him in the people we meet along the way. In the people who show kindness and warmth to someone who is homeless, in the care of a wife for her dying husband, in the joy that a child can bring to the family, in the generosity of someone supporting a person with long term mental-health difficulties. On these occasions and others when our hearts are warmed and burn with admiration, it is because we have recognised Christ's presence. Like it or not life takes us through times of crucifixion, trials, sufferings, disappointments, unfair and unjust treatment, envy, jealousy some of which endure. The Easter experience states categorically that however long the wait, resurrection, new life, new joy, new hope will follow.

If or when our hopes and dreams are shattered and we believe that Jesus has left us and we turn away seeking some sort of solace far away (Emmaus), we never ever quite reach Emmaus. In one guise or another, Christ will always meet us on the road, burn holes in our hearts, explain the latest crucifixion to us, and send us back - to Galilee (our hearts) - and to our abandoned discipleship. Only there in the Galilee of our hearts will it all make sense for us once again. (Ronald Rolheiser)
