Reflection Thursday 5th Week Lent 2023

When Moses was in the desert tending Jethro's sheep, he encountered the burning bush. As he approached a voice asked him to take off his shoes because he was standing on holy ground. In the encounter Moses asked who was addressing him and the answer he received was "I AM!" So, when Jesus used those words about himself, the Jews automatically said he was blaspheming.

The journey, pilgrimage, that we make through Lent is not towards a burning bush but towards the glory, splendour and light of the Resurrection. But, it is a pilgrimage made on Holy Ground because we make this pilgrimage with God, the promise made to Abraham that God would journey with us always.

To call himself I Am! Shows that God lives always in the present and Lent is the time to see how close God journeys with us each day and each moment of each day and be reassured of God's presence. It is presence of love and forgiveness, of help and support, of wisdom and courage and also of comforting reassurance.
