A Prayer for Asylum Seekers and Refugees: Lord Jesus, you call us to welcome members of God's family who come here to escape oppression, poverty, persecution, violence, and war. Help us not be fearful, doubtful or suspicious. Help us welcome migrants and refugees with joy and generosity, realize that you call us to learn the ways of peace and justice, share of our abundance and witness to your love for everyone, as we celebrate the many gifts they bring. We make this prayer in Jesus' name. Amen.

Ramblings Faith in God, in Jesus Christ, is full of paradoxes. We are asked to fear God but not fear death. Using fear in reference to God is about showing God the utmost respect, the greatest honour and to put God in first place. Jesus encourages us not to fear death in a way that debilitates us, that freezes us from life, that creates a sense of hopelessness and despair. But death does demand respect because it offers us the ultimate opportunity to place our lives totally in God's hands and having complete trust in Him.

Macrina Wiederkehr osb, who died not long ago, wrote:

There is something in me that is not content to hang about directionless along the edge of the path ... A thirst in me so deep it will move aside the rocks, seeking moisture. There is a yearning that is intense in its desire to put God first. It may take a lifetime, but I have no doubt this unnameable Mystery within, the seed that fell at the beginning of creation, will finally crowd out the thorns. Yes, there is One who believes in me enough to continue singing up the country of my heart.

The One who believes in her eventually sang her into heaven. She died leaving these words:

O Light of Revelation, when dawn shows its face and when the shades of twilight enfold me, may I receive the peace that comes from being in communion with you. You who are a window to the eternal, hold me in your view. Don't ever let me out of sight. Death will hold no terror for me, sheltered under your wings. May I rest in peace in life and in death."
