How he had written it I do not know. He had never written it before and has never written it since. But he did it that day. He held it up very proudly. "That's very good, Guy," I said. "Do you want to play want me to play with you now?"

He grinned and I left my typewriter and so we sat down and drew airplanes and cows and trains and I thought there aren't many fathers who could gain a sense of joy in seeing a twenty-year-old son's writing of a name.

Loving your neighbour means loving them as they are. It's the best way to show love for God!!
