#### Prayer for those seeking sanctuary

**Ramblings** Hypocrisy! A word we dislike but see in others and rarely in ourselves. Many make efforts not to be hypocritical and yet it still taints their lives, often unknowingly. In fact, some people are so busy pointing out the hypocrisy of others that they forget to look in a mirror!! Jesus was well aware of the hypocrisy of the Scribes and Pharisees even if not all were like that. He calls them out on it and lays it bare.

George Orwell: the Ministry of Peace concerns itself with war, the Ministry of Truth with lies, the Ministry of Love with torture and the Ministry of Plenty with starvation. These contradictions are not accidental, nor do they result from ordinary hypocrisy: they are deliberate exercises in doublethink"

Pope Francis: Hypocrisy can be called the fear of the truth; that it is better to pretend than to be yourself. This can suffocate the courage to openly say what is true. The Bible tells us about Eleazar, in the time of the Maccabees, who refused to pretend to eat meat sacrificed to idols, even at the cost of his life. Hypocrites are people who pretend, flatter, and deceive because they live behind a mask not having the courage to face the truth. They are incapable of truly loving.

One Sunday morning during service, a 2,000member congregation was surprised to see two men enter, covered from head to toe in black and carrying sub-machine guns. One of the men shouted, "Anyone willing to take a bullet for Christ, remain where you are."

Immediately, the choir fled, the deacons fled, and most of the congregation fled. Out of the 2,000, only about 20 remained. The man who had spoken took off his hood, looked at the preacher and said, "Okay Pastor, I got rid of all the hypocrites. Now you may begin your service. Have a nice day!" And the two men turned and walked out.
