The author of Wisdom was well aware of this, thousands of years ago. The question Wisdom poses today focuses on power and authority both of which are the subject of great debate and different understandings. Raised to a higher position of government, people seem to believe that they own power and authority because of their position. Being told that all power and authority come from God, as Jesus told Pilate at his trial, those given the responsibility of governing should realise that power and authority is only to be used to help, guide, and promote the people they serve for the common good. They are not to be used for themselves.

Pope Francis says: "Real authority is born from good example, in order to help others practice what is right and proper, supporting them in the trials that they encounter on the path of good. However, if it is exercised badly, it becomes oppressive, it does not allow people to grow and it creates a climate of mistrust and hostility and even breads corruption. Therefore, if we have received certain qualities or authority from God, then we must put these at the service of others, rather than trying to take advantage of them for our own interests and personal satisfaction."
