Prayer for those seeking sanctuary

Ramblings As we approach Pentecost, the Sunday readings help us start thinking about the importance of the Holy Spirit in our lives and the love that the Holy Spirit offers us through Jesus Christ.

John Foley sj describes the Holy Spirit as the one who makes us able to say "yes" to faith. The Holy Spirit does not treat us roughly or try to overpower us but offers us what we can call a "respectful love." This is a divine presence that never overpowers but always respects and guides our choice(s). Rather than dictate, the Spirit wants to be a close companion, respectful of our being, not contradicting it but bringing out what is most truly our own self.

He adds that the Holy Spirit always waits for us to open ourselves to Jesus' life. For Christ is not gone, he is inside us, knocking at our inner door. Of course, we can say no but we can also say yes with our lives using the same respectful love given by Holy Spirit.

So, love becomes an essential part of our being and of our doing. We are therefore made to be channels of God's love as shown to us by our *mothers*:

At last, in spite of all, a recognition, for those who loved and laboured for so long, who brought us, through that labour, to fruition, to flourish in the place where we belong. A thanks to those who stayed and did the raising, who buckled down and did the work of two, whom governments have mocked instead of praising,

who hid their heart-break and still struggled through;

the single mothers forced onto the edge whose work the world has overlooked, neglected, invisible to wealth and privilege,

but in whose lives the kingdom is reflected.
