

GOSPEL: John 13: 31–35

*I give you a new commandment: love one another.*

**My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,**

**THIS FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER WE HAVE A PASTORAL LETTER FROM THE CARDINAL** (brought forward from next Sunday, as we have a visiting preacher next weekend ... see below). In it he presents to us some of the themes from the Pope's recent Apostolic Exhortation (a teaching document following on from the Oct 2014 and Oct 2015 synods of bishops at the Vatican). *Amoris Laetitia* is a very beautiful presentation on marriage and family life, and I will look for ways of sharing its contents more deeply with you in the coming weeks.


**THE 'DIVINE MERCY' DEVOTION**, about which I preached on the Second Sunday of Easter, is a powerful prayer that was revealed to and promoted by the Polish nun of the early 20<sup>th</sup> c., St Faustina Kowalska. Next Sunday, a Polish priest from the community of Marian Fathers in Ealing, Fr Andrzej, will be coming to preach to us at each of the Masses about this 'Divine Mercy' prayer. We look forward to his visit so as to deepen our appreciation of the Lord's deep and everlasting mercy for each one of us in our daily lives.

**OUR PARISH COURSE, "THE GIFT,"** on living fully in the Holy Spirit, began very encouragingly last Tuesday, with many attendees, but there is still some room for more if you wish to attend. There are 5 more weeks of the course to run, each Tuesday at 7.30pm, so please feel free to come along this Tuesday for the 2<sup>nd</sup> session, on "The Joy of the Gospel."



**From Misericordiae Vultus, Pope Francis on the 'Holy Year of Mercy,' n. 13:**



We want to live this Jubilee Year in light of the Lord's words: *Merciful like the Father*. The Evangelist reminds us of the teaching of Jesus who says, "Be merciful just as your Father is merciful." It is a programme of life as demanding as it is rich with joy and peace. Jesus's command is directed to anyone willing to listen to his voice. In order to be capable of mercy, therefore, we must first of all dispose ourselves to listen to the Word of God. This means rediscovering the value of silence in order to meditate on the Word that comes to us. In

this way, it will be possible to contemplate God's mercy and adopt it as our lifestyle.

On the noticeboard is now posted the most recent summary of our parish's 'Growing in Faith' donations, which benefit both the diocese, and our own parish's project of employing a part-time catechetical co-ordinator. **We have raised pledges of c. £190k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £55k.**

An information pack is available now from the presbytery. Once you have completed the form and returned it to the presbytery, your name will be added to the weekly sign-in-sheet which will be available in the church porch on the noticeboard (by the fire-exit door) for signing after the Saturday evening vigil Mass and the Masses of Sunday. On this basis Fr Philip will be in a better position to judge whether he can issue the Certificate you ask for.
