



GOSPEL: Luke 7: 36–8:3

Her many sins have been forgiven, or she would not have shown such great love.

My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,

THE SCENE RECOUNTED IN TODAY'S GOSPEL PASSAGE is a powerful moment in which Our Lord reveals the depths of His mercy, extending His forgiveness to this woman who suddenly bursts in and approaches Him in the house of Simon the Pharisee. Our Lord does not gloss over her grave wrongdoing, but recognises the love and repentance that are genuinely in her heart, and forgives her. Such a moment of being forgiven can change one's life! In this Holy Year of Mercy, let's make sure that we are regularly availing ourselves of Jesus's mercy, coming into His very presence in Confession, kneeling at His feet, and hearing His words: "Your sins are forgiven"!



THIS WEEKEND'S HOMILY ON THE POPE'S APOSTOLIC EXHORTATION AMORIS LAETITIA is on the 5th chapter of the document, entitled 'Love Made Fruitful,' which is about the joy and blessing of children born in the loving environment of Christian Marriage. freedom to those in captivity; to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour." A 'year of the Lord's favour' or 'mercy': this is what the Lord proclaimed and this is what we wish to live now. This Holy Year will bring to the fore the richness of Jesus's mission echoed in the words of the prophet: to bring a word and gesture of consolation to the poor, to proclaim liberty to those bound by new forms of slavery in modern society, to restore sight to those who can see no more because they are caught up in themselves, to restore dignity to all those from whom it has been robbed. The preaching of Jesus is made visible once more in the response of faith which Christians are called to offer by their witness. May the words of the Apostle accompany us: he who does acts of mercy, let him do them with cheerfulness.

In the Gospel of Luke, we find another important element that will help us live the Jubilee with faith. Luke writes that Jesus, on the Sabbath, went back to Nazareth and, as was his custom, entered the synagogue. They called upon him to read the Scripture and to comment on it. The passage was from the Book of Isaiah where it is written: "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to bring good tidings to the afflicted; he has sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and

CATECHETICS

FIRST-HOLY-COMMUNION PROGRAMME: a practice will be held on **Sat 18th June at 2pm** for the children receiving their first Holy Communion on Sun 19th June. Practice on Sat 25th June 11.30am for 1st Holy Communion on Sun 26th June. All children must attend their practice, so that they know what to do. The **Thanksgiving Mass** will be held on **Sunday 3rd July** at 11.15am Mass when all First Communicants from both weeks return in their First Communion outfits for the Mass. **If you are a prayer partner, please collect a card from the back of church.**

BAPTISM COURSE: The next course will be held on **Fri 24th June and Mon 4th July 7.30-9.00pm** in the presbytery. The course must be completed before a Baptism can be arranged. To book onto the course, please contact the presbytery.

On the noticeboard is now posted the most recent summary of our parish's 'Growing in Faith' donations, which benefit both the diocese, and our own parish's project of employing a part-time catechetical co-ordinator. **We have raised pledges of c. £190k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £55k.**

As yet we have not sourced anyone to take up the post of a parish catechist, but Fr Philip is in discussion with friends in the diocese who have experience in this area, to try and find a recommended and suitably qualified person for the post. Do pray that this can come about soon.

SCHOOLS/UNDER-5s

CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE: If your child is presently in year 5 and would wish to go to St Mary's or another Catholic secondary school in 2017, or if your child is looking to go into Reception year in a Catholic Primary school in autumn 2017, then you will need to apply immediately to go on the list for requesting a 'Certificate of Catholic Practice' towards the end of 2016. An information pack is available now from the presbytery. Once you have completed the form and returned it to the presbytery, your name will be added to the weekly sign-in-sheet which will be available in the church porch on the noticeboard (by the fire-exit door) for signing after the Saturday evening vigil Mass and the Masses of Sunday. On this basis Fr Philip will be in a better position to judge whether he can issue the Certificate you ask for.
