

My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,

THE IMPORTANT EU REFERENDUM TAKES PLACE THIS WEEK, and amidst all the confusing cacophony of the referendum debates and against the sad background of the killing of the MP, Jo Cox, we must each cast our vote. Last week, I included with the newsletter a statement by the Bishops of England & Wales regarding the referendum. Whilst they would not indicate a specific way to vote, as that must be left to our individual conscience, yet they ask us to pray about our choice. They also stated: "We all have a responsibility to keep the dignity of the human person at the forefront of the debate. We must ask ourselves, in the face of every issue, what will best serve the dignity of all people both within Europe and beyond." May the Lord truly guide us, in this complex matter, to do what is right.



I CONTINUE MY CYCLE OF HOMILIES ON THE POPE'S APOSTOLIC EXHORTATION AMORIS LAETITIA and this weekend will draw some themes out from the 6th chapter of his document, "Some Pastoral Perspectives." Once again, the Pope has much to say in encouraging our day-to-day living-out of Christian marriages and family life, and we will do well to listen to his wisdom.

THIS YEAR'S FIRST-HOLY-COMMUNION CELEBRATIONS take place over two weekends, and we thank God for these children who are approaching the altar for their first reception of the Body and Blood of the Lord. May they be guided by their families always to be devout recipients of the Most Blessed Eucharist, who is Jesus Himself, the living Heart of the Church.

The pages of the prophet Isaiah can also be meditated upon concretely: "Is not this the fast that I choose: to loosen the bonds of wickedness, to undo the thongs of the yoke, to let the oppressed go free, and to break every yoke? Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, and bring the homeless poor into your house; when you see the naked, to cover him, and not to hide yourself from your own flesh? Then shall your light break forth like the dawn, and your healing shall spring up speedily; your righteousness shall go before you, the glory

of the Lord shall be your rear guard. Then you shall call, and the Lord will answer; you shall cry, and he will say, here I am. If you take away from the midst of you the yoke, the pointing of the finger, and speaking wickedness, if you pour yourself out for the hungry and satisfy the desire of the afflicted, then shall your light rise in the darkness and your gloom be as the noonday. And the Lord will guide you continually, and satisfy your desire with good things, and make your bones strong; and you shall be like a watered garden, like a spring of water, whose waters fail not." CATECHETICS

FIRST-HOLY-COMMUNION PROGRAMME: A practice will be held on **Sat 25th June 11.30am** for 1st Holy Communion on Sun 26th June. All

children must attend their practice, so that they know what to do. The **Thanksgiving Mass** will be held on **Sunday 3rd July** at 11.15am Mass when all First Communicants from both weeks return in their First Communion outfits for Mass.

BAPTISM COURSE: The next course will be held on **Fri 24th June and Mon 4th July** 7.30-9.00pm in the presbytery. The course must be completed before a Baptism can be arranged. To book onto the course, please contact the presbytery.

CONFIRMATION 2017: Fr Philip wishes to see each candidate (in next year's year 9 or above) and a parent for a short chat (20–30 minutes) before the summer. **Applications will close for this programme on 8th July.** Please contact the presbytery for an appointment. On the noticeboard is now posted the most recent summary of our parish's 'Growing in Faith' donations, which benefit both the diocese, and our own parish's project of employing a part-time catechetical co-ordinator. **We have raised pledges of c. £190k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £55k.**

As yet we have not sourced anyone to take up the post of a parish catechist, but Fr Philip is in discussion with friends in the diocese who have experience in this area, to try and find a recommended and suitably qualified person for the post. Do pray that this can come about soon.

SCHOOLS/UNDER-5s

CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE: If your child is presently in year 5 and would wish to go to St Mary's or another Catholic secondary school in 2017, or if your child is looking to go into Reception year in a Catholic Primary school in autumn 2017, then you will need to apply immediately to go on the list for requesting a 'Certificate of Catholic Practice' towards the end of 2016. An information pack is available now from the presbytery. Once you have completed the form and returned it to the presbytery, your name will be added to the weekly sign-in-sheet which will be available in the church porch on the noticeboard (by the fire-exit door) for signing after the Saturday evening vigil Mass and the

Masses of Sunday. On this basis Fr Philip will be in a better position to judge whether he can issue the Certificate you ask for.
