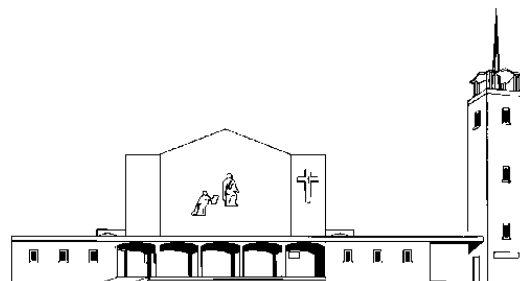

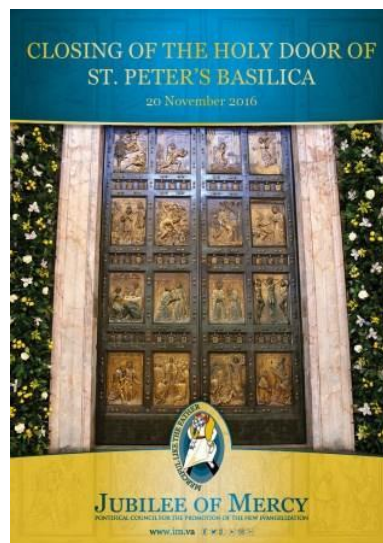
**My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,**

THE JUBILEE HOLY YEAR OF MERCY 2015/16 comes to a close this weekend with the feast of Christ the King, and the Holy Door of St Peter's basilica will be symbolically closed and sealed up this Sunday, to be opened again in the next Holy Year, whenever that is – maybe not until 2025. The feast of Christ the King is a beautiful way to end each Church year: it reminds us of the triumph of our Lord and Saviour, and His majesty, the fact that all things are ultimately His, and that our happiness lies in being firmly in His Kingdom. We hear in the Gospel of this feast day the mercy that continually springs forth from the Lord on His throne of glory, the Cross, as He offers to the repentant thief the promise of paradise.

THE CATHOLIC CHARITY, 'AID TO THE CHURCH IN NEED,' is participating in an important event in London this Wednesday evening, 23<sup>rd</sup> Nov. It's called 'Red Wednesday' and is a chance to pray for all Christians and others, who give their lives for their peacefully-held beliefs. The Cathedral will be floodlit in red, as will Westminster Abbey. Holy Mass is available in Westminster Cathedral 5.30-6.30pm; everyone else to gather in the Cathedral piazza from 6pm for a **6.30pm start**. Alongside music and films, there are invited speakers; it ends at 7.20pm.

NEXT WEEKEND, AS WE BEGIN OUR ADVENT SEASON, we will have our annual charity fair in the church crypt after each of the Masses: it's a lovely way to purchase some charity Christmas cards etc., and to enter into the spirit of the season of Advent. It's a time when we should not only be thinking of ourselves – our own practical preparations for Christmas – but also to be reaching out: how are others spending Christmas? ... whom should I be inviting for Christmas who might otherwise be alone? ... how can I contribute to charities in my Christmas spending?

## CATECHETICS

**'SYCAMORE':** Fr Philip is showing a DVD series called 'Sycamore' on **Wednesdays at 10.15am** after coffee in the crypt. Dates are 23<sup>rd</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> November. All welcome! This week's theme: **"The meaning of love."**

**BAPTISM COURSE:** The second part of the current course will be held on **Fri 25<sup>th</sup> Nov, 7.30pm–9pm** in the church.

**ADULT CONFIRMATION COURSE:** Tuesday evenings, continues on **22<sup>nd</sup> November (8–9.30pm)**.

**CONFIRMATION 2017:** The next session will be on **28<sup>th</sup> Nov at 7.15–8.45pm** in the crypt for **candidates only**. Candidates will need to have read chapter 8 of the Gospel of Mark. **We have slightly adjusted the times of the Confirmation Masses on the 7<sup>th</sup> May 2017 to 1.15pm and 4pm. However, the numbers for each Mass are very unbalanced. About 10 candidates need to swap from 1.15pm to 4pm.** If no one does this voluntarily, then we may have to use a ballot to decide on the allocation.

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME:** The third meeting for parents will be on **Wed 30<sup>th</sup> Nov 8–9pm** in the crypt. The third session for children will be on **Mon 5<sup>th</sup> Dec 6–7.30pm**. **FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 'PRAYER PARTNERS'** are needed for all the children on the First Holy Communion programme. A prayer partner prays for a child whilst they are preparing to make their Communion. If you would like to become a prayer partner, please print your name in capital letters on the blue list at the back of the church. **Could parents please ensure that the children do not sign the blue prayer partner list instead of the register.**

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION - MASS OF ENROLMENT - Next weekend** at all Masses, we will formally welcome onto the programme those children preparing for their First Holy Communion. We will pray for them and hear them commit themselves to their course.



On the noticeboard is now posted the most recent summary of our parish's 'Growing in Faith' donations, which benefit both the diocese, and our own parish's project of employing a part-time catechetical co-ordinator. **We have raised pledges of c. £190k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £55k.** As yet we have not sourced anyone to take up the post of a parish catechist, but Fr Philip is in discussion with friends in the diocese who have experience in this area, to try and find a recommended and suitably qualified person for the post. Do pray that this can come about soon.
