

Luke 17: 5-10 – *If only you had faith!*

**My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,**

AS I MENTIONED LAST WEEK, SR MARION CONNAUGHTY of the Sisters of Our Lady died recently. For a decade or so (till the year 2000) she was the Head Teacher of St Cross Primary School. Her funeral will take place this week in Kettering, but here in Hoddesdon we will have an opportunity to pray for her at Mass with St Cross School on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October, 10.45am. More details inside the Newsletter. All friends of Sr Marion, plus former pupils, staff and governors of St Cross, are warmly encouraged to attend this Mass.

NOW THAT IT IS THE SEASON FOR PARENTS OF YEAR-6 CHILDREN to be making choices over applications to Secondary School, might I remind you again that Herts county council is letting St Mary's take an *extra form of pupils* into Year 7 in September 2017. Parents are, therefore, *strongly encouraged* to place St Mary's as their no.1 choice of school on the county submission, as the school has the hope of admitting any and every Catholic child into St Mary's next year.



**From Misericordiae Vultus, Pope Francis on the 'Holy Year of Mercy,' n. 25:**

St Cross schoolchildren will be involved in the readings, bidding prayers and music, as we pray for, and give thanks for, Sister Marion and the Sisters of Our Lady's legacy to St Cross school. All past pupils and families, staff and governors of St Cross are warmly invited to come to this Mass, along with current school families and friends. On return to school, after lunch there will be a celebratory afternoon where the children will remember the significance of the Sisters of Our Lady in the history of St Cross. There will be an 'open afternoon' so any visitors will be warmly welcome to come along to St Cross School. Teas and coffee will be available. We hope to see many of you there.

## CATECHETICS

**'SYCAMORE':** Fr Philip will be showing a DVD series called 'Sycamore' on **Wednesdays at 10.15am** after coffee in the crypt. Dates are 5<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, Oct; 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> November. All welcome!

**BAPTISM COURSE:** The next course will be held on **Fri 11th and 25th Nov 7.30pm-9pm** in the presbytery. The course must be completed

**ADULT CONFIRMATION:** Tuesday evenings, beginning 8<sup>th</sup> November (8-9.30pm). Fr Philip will be running a 2-month adult Confirmation programme, with a view to participating in the ceremony of Confirmation at Westminster Cathedral on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> January 2017 at the 6pm Mass. **CONFIRMATION 2017:** The next session will be on 3<sup>rd</sup> Oct at 7.15-8.45pm in the crypt for candidates and parents. Candidates will need to have read chapter 4 of the Gospel of Mark. As mentioned in the parents' letter in July there will be a £10 cost for materials, so please forward this to the presbytery soon.

On the noticeboard is now posted the most recent summary of our parish's 'Growing in Faith' donations, which benefit both the diocese, and our own parish's project of employing a part-time catechetical co-ordinator. We have raised pledges of c. £190k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £55k. As yet we have not sourced anyone to take up the post of a parish catechist, but Fr Philip is in discussion with friends in the diocese who have experience in this area, to try and find a recommended and suitably qualified person for the post.
