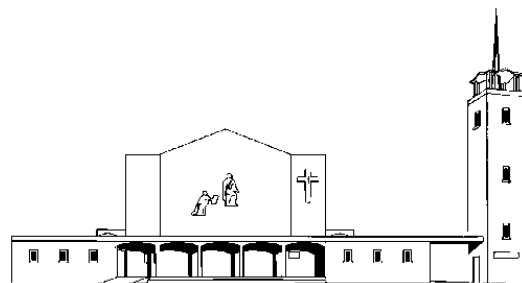

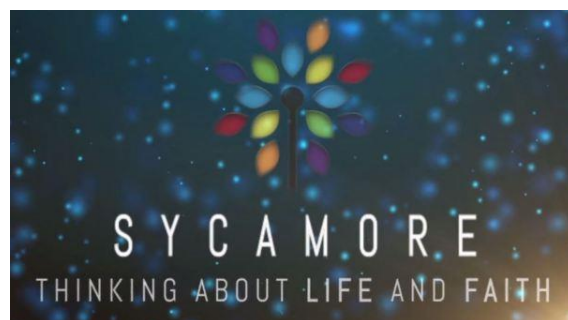
Year C **TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR 11TH SEPTEMBER 2016**

Luke 15: 1-32 *There will be rejoicing in heaven over one repentant sinner.*

My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,

THE FAMOUS GOSPEL PARABLE THIS SUNDAY, the 'Prodigal Son,' forms the centrepiece of our 'Holy Year of Mercy' Gospels. We heard it in the middle of Lent; now we hear it once again, and maybe that's no bad thing! It's a great reminder of our being fully, still, in this Holy Year – it closes on the Sunday of 'Christ the King' in November. I urge you, if you haven't done so, to visit the table in the porch with the selection of 'Mercy' reading. Please, maybe think of buying one little booklet for spiritual reflection in the remaining weeks of this Holy Year. Also: keep free the service for the closing of the Holy Door at Waltham Cross: **Sun 13th Nov at 3pm.**

I AM SCREENING ON WEDNESDAY MORNINGS this autumn a series of short videos on the faith, which go under the title of 'Sycamore'. The word 'Sycamore' alludes to the meeting between Zacchaeus and Jesus in ch. 19 of St Luke's Gospel. As Jesus enters Jericho, Zacchaeus longs to see him, but he is too short, and the crowds are too big. So he climbs a sycamore tree in order to get a better view. The Sycamore programme is about helping people to get a richer perspective on the big questions of life and faith, and allowing them to meet Christ in their own time, on their own terms, just as Zacchaeus did in the streets of Jericho. From Misericordiae Vultus, Pope Francis on the 'Holy Year of Mercy,' n. 23:



There is an aspect of mercy that goes beyond the confines of the Church. It relates us to Judaism and Islam, both of which consider mercy to be one of God's most important attributes. Israel was the first to receive this revelation which continues in history as the source of an inexhaustible richness meant to be shared with all mankind. As we have seen, the pages of the Old Testament are steeped in mercy, because they narrate the works that the Lord performed in favour of his people at the most trying moments of their history. Among the privileged names that Islam attributes to the Creator are "Merciful and Kind". This invocation is often on the lips of faithful Muslims who feel themselves accompanied and sustained by mercy in their daily weakness. They too believe that no one can place a limit on divine mercy because its doors are always open. I trust that this Jubilee year celebrating the mercy of God will foster an encounter with these religions and with other noble religious traditions; may it open us to even more fervent dialogue so that we might know and understand one another better; may it eliminate every form of closed-mindedness and disrespect, and drive out every form of violence and discrimination.

CATECHETICS

CONFIRMATION 2017: The next session will be on **12th September at 7.15-8.45pm** in the crypt for **parents and candidates**. As mentioned in the parents' letter in July there will be a £10 cost for materials, so please forward this to the presbytery soon.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME: Application forms for the new First Holy Communion Programme (for practising Catholic children in year 3 or above) **are now available to collect after all Masses this weekend** (and not available from the Presbytery). Please return completed forms to the presbytery by 3rd October. **The first meeting for parents will be on Wed 5th Oct 8–9pm in the crypt. The first session for children will be on Mon 10th October 6–7.30pm.**

"RCIA" – 'Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults' is the programme for preparation for adults wishing to become Catholics, or be prepared for the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion). **The course will continue on 13th Sept at 7pm.** If

anyone is considering becoming a Catholic (or is an adult Catholic wishing to be confirmed,) please contact Fr Philip as soon as possible. There are green leaflets outlining RCIA by newsletters.



On the noticeboard is now posted the most recent summary of our parish's 'Growing in Faith' donations, which benefit both the diocese, and our own parish's project of employing a part-time catechetical co-ordinator. **We have raised pledges of c. £190k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £55k.** As yet we have not sourced anyone to take up the post of a parish catechist, but Fr Philip is in discussion with friends in the diocese who have experience in this area, to try and find a recommended and suitably qualified person for the post. Do pray that this can come about soon.
