


THERE IS GREAT NEWS REGARDING ST MARY'S CATHOLIC SECONDARY SCHOOL! Mr Celano, the Headteacher, has written to the parishes and Primary Schools of our area to inform us that the county is letting St Mary's take an extra form of pupils into Year 7 in September 2017 – that's an extra 31 children. SO: those whose children are currently in Year 6 are strongly encouraged to place St Mary's as their no.1 choice of school on the county submission, as the school has every likelihood of admitting any and every Catholic child into St Mary's next year.

From *Misericordiae Vultus*, Pope Francis on the 'Holy Year of Mercy,' n. 24:



My thoughts now turn to the Mother of Mercy. May the sweetness of her countenance watch over us in this Holy Year, so that all of us may rediscover the joy of God's tenderness. No one has penetrated the profound mystery of the incarnation like Mary. Her entire life was patterned after the presence of mercy made flesh. The Mother of the Crucified and Risen One has entered the sanctuary of divine mercy because she participated intimately in the mystery of His love.

Chosen to be the Mother of the Son of God, Mary, from the outset, was prepared by the love of God to be the *Ark of the Covenant* between God and man. She treasured divine mercy in her heart in perfect harmony with her Son Jesus. Her hymn of praise, sung at the threshold of the home of Elizabeth, was dedicated to the mercy of God which extends from "generation to generation." We too were included in those prophetic words of the Virgin Mary. This will be a source of comfort and strength to us as we cross the threshold of the Holy Year to experience the fruits of divine mercy.

On the noticeboard is now posted the most recent summary of our parish's 'Growing in Faith' donations, which benefit both the diocese, and our own parish's project of employing a part-time catechetical co-ordinator. **We have raised pledges of c. £190k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £55k.** As yet we have not sourced anyone to take up the post of a parish catechist, but Fr Philip is in discussion with friends in the diocese who have experience in this area, to try and find a recommended and suitably qualified person for the post.
