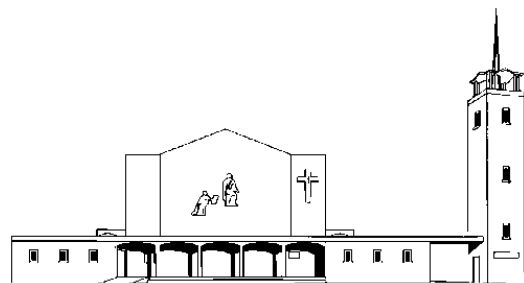

WE BEGIN THE BEAUTIFUL SEASON OF ADVENT TODAY!

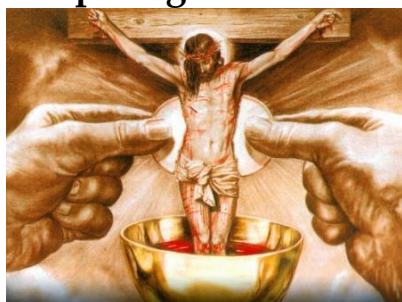

THERE ARE SOME VERY IMPORTANT ITEMS INSIDE THE NEWSLETTER, so please read and act on them, as a keen expression of love for your neighbour, as I spoke about in last week's homily:

1. The walk-in swab testing at Stanborough Club (Tues or Thurs) to search for a bone-marrow donor.

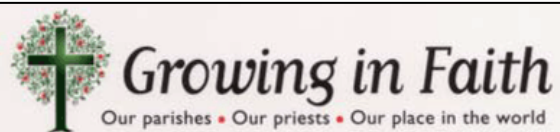
"RCIA" - 'Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults' is the programme for preparation for adults wishing to become Catholics, or be prepared for the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion). **The course continues on Mon 4th Dec.**

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME: Next meeting for parents is on **Wed 6th Dec 8-9pm** in the crypt. The third session for children will be on **Mon 11th Dec 6-7.30pm.**

'PRAYER PARTNERS' are needed for the First-Holy-Communion children. A prayer partner prays for a child whilst they are preparing on this year's programme. Please print your name on the blue list at the back of the church. **Could parents please ensure that the children do not sign the blue prayer partner list instead of the register.**

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION – MASS OF ENROLMENT – Next weekend at all Masses, we will formally welcome onto the programme those children preparing for their First Holy Communion. We will pray for them and hear them commit themselves to their course.

BAPTISM COURSE: The next course will be held on **Tuesday 16th and Wednesday 24th January 2018** 7.30-9pm in the presbytery. To enrol on the course, please contact the presbytery. The course must be completed before a Baptism can be arranged.



Our fundraising began in 2014, and **we have pledged of c. £185k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £51k.** So far we already have £24k available for our parish project, which is to employ a part-time worker in the area of catechetics and evangelization. Fr Philip is working with the diocese and seeking advice from other diocesan priests to draw up a job description to find the right person for this role.

SCHOOLS/UNDER-5s

CATHOLIC SCHOOLS: Do you support Catholic schools and the right of Catholics to send their children to them? Then we need you to make your voice heard. The Government is making a critical decision on whether to overturn the admissions cap which prevents Catholic schools from allowing all Catholic pupils to attend. They have acknowledged that this policy discriminates against Catholics and promised to abandon it; now we need you to tell them not to U-turn on their promise to Catholics. Visit <http://catholicnews.org.uk/> or search for 'Catholic Education' in your search engine to write to the Government and urge them to drop their policy which bans new Catholic schools.
