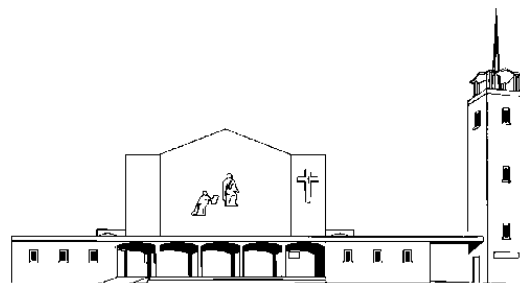

My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,

THIS WEEK — 18<sup>TH</sup> TO 25<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY — is always designated as the Octave of Prayer for Christian Unity, as it is a tragedy that baptized Christians have become divided over the centuries into different denominations. This Week of Prayer is an opportunity for us to renew our desire for Christian Unity, the coming-together of all Christians into one global family in Christ. Naturally, we believe that there are certain things that are "from Christ" and which cannot be given up in a 'common denominator' compromise — the true nature of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is a case in point — but the Catholic Church is committed to the constant dialogue and co-operation in order to defuse tensions between Christians, and to foster unity.

In our own local area, we have this Sunday the **Service of Prayer for Christian Unity** at St Cuthbert's, in the Rye Road area of the parish (Whitley Road) at 6.30pm. Do come along to join others of our parish to the congregation of our Christian brothers and sisters in Hoddesdon, Broxbourne & Wormley, to pray together and express our common Baptism into Jesus.

I ENJOYED MY CLERGY PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY LAND, and am grateful to the priests who assisted in coming to celebrate Mass, and to all those parishioners who had to do 'extra' in my absence. 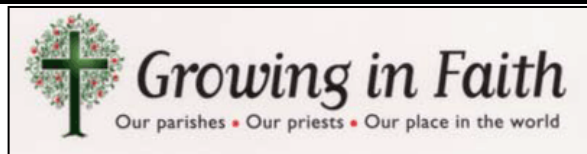

## CATECHETICS

**BAPTISM COURSE** this month finishes **Fri 27<sup>th</sup> Jan 7.30-9pm** in the church. A course must be completed before a Baptism can be arranged.

**CONFIRMATION 2017:** next session **23<sup>rd</sup> Jan at 7.15-8.45pm** for **candidates and parents**. Candidates need to have read chs 9 & 10 of the Mark's Gospel. We have slightly adjusted the times of the Confirmation Masses on the **7<sup>th</sup> May 2017 to 1.15pm and 4pm**. However, the numbers for each Mass are very unbalanced. **10 candidates need to swap from 1.15pm to 4pm**. If no one does this voluntarily, then we may have to use a ballot to decide on the allocation.

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME:** The fifth meeting for parents will be on **Wed 22<sup>nd</sup> Feb 8-9pm** in the crypt. The fifth session for children will be on **Mon 27<sup>th</sup> Feb 6-7.30pm**.



On the noticeboard is now posted the most recent summary of our parish's 'Growing in Faith' donations, which benefit both the

diocese, and our own parish's project of employing a part-time catechetical co-ordinator. **We have raised pledges of c. £190k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £55k.** As yet we have not sourced anyone to take up the post of a parish catechist, but Fr Philip is in discussion with friends in the diocese who have experience in this area, to try and find a recommended and suitably qualified person for the post. Do pray that this can come about soon.

### SCHOOLS/UNDER-5s

**CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE:** If your child is presently in year 5 and would wish to go to St Mary's or another Catholic secondary school in 2018, or if your child is looking to go into Reception year in a Catholic Primary school in autumn 2018, then you will need to apply **immediately** to go on the list for requesting a 'Certificate of Catholic Practice' towards the end of 2017. An information pack is **available now** from the presbytery. Once you have completed the form and returned it to the presbytery, your name will be added to the weekly sign-in-sheet which will be available in the church porch on the noticeboard (by the fire-exit door) for signing after the Saturday evening vigil Mass and the Masses of Sunday. On this basis Fr Philip will be in a better position to judge whether he can issue the Certificate you ask for.
