

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

12<sup>th</sup> MARCH 2017

Matthew 17: 1-9 – *His face shone like the sun.*

**My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,**

ON THIS SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT, we hear of the Lord's glorious Transfiguration. After hearing of His 40 Days in the Wilderness last Sunday, this weekend we hear of His letting the closest three apostles glimpse His divinity on the Mount of the Transfiguration. It must have helped them enormously when it came to the time of Jesus's arrest, trial, passion and death, that they had already seen a little something of His true nature as the Son of God. It helps us, too, in these early stages of Lent, that we know of the Godhead of the Lord Jesus, and that the One whom we try to serve more closely than ever in this sacred season has the power to overcome all things, even sin and death. As St Peter says, "It is wonderful for us to be here!" – and it is! It is truly wonderful that we can be in the company of the Lord Jesus, to experience His love and His power whenever we are at Mass. As His body and blood are lifted up at Mass, we know that we are beholding the glory, usually hidden, of the only One who has the power to save us from our sins, and give us life after death.



CELEBRATING THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION is a very important part of our Lenten practice for all of us. The classes of Years 4, 5, and 6 in the Catholic Primary schools have the Sacrament in school with Fr Philip on the Tuesdays of Lent. And the Confirmation candidates and their parents are celebrating the Sacrament at their next session. I want to make the Sacrament as available as possible to you during this penitential season, so I will hear Confessions after all the Saturday evening / Sunday Masses of Lent. But I have also set aside some other quiet opportunities, and the first is ...

**THIS TUESDAY, 14<sup>TH</sup> MARCH, 6-7PM – CONFESSION AVAILABLE IN CHURCH**

I will be available in the Confessional during this hour for anyone to come for the Sacrament.

The celebration of mercy takes place in a very particular way in the *Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation*. Here we feel the embrace of the Father, who comes forth to meet us and grant us the grace of being once more his sons and daughters. We are sinners and we bear the burden of contradiction between what we wish to do and what we do in fact. Yet grace always precedes us and takes on the face of the mercy that effects our reconciliation and pardon. God makes us understand his great love for us precisely when we recognize that we are sinners. Grace is stronger than sin: it overcomes resistance, because love conquers all.

## LENT

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS:** the "Way of the Cross" prayed in church each Friday (12.30pm, after Mass), & Saturday (9.30am, before Mass.) And in Italian at 5.30pm each Friday.

**PARISH "PENANCE" FOR LENT:** In Lent, we will as usual have no final hymn at Sunday Mass, and then we will **keep silence** in the body of the church, so as to allow a period of prayer for those who wish to remain after Mass in Thanksgiving. Fr Philip will also go to the Confessional at this time for anyone wishing to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

**LENTEN ALMS:** This year the Cardinal has asked that the Lenten Alms be directed to the Cardinal's Appeal fund. The funds raised will go to support parishes or groups in their work to further the mission of the Church: to serve the evangelisation of youth, to develop marriage and family life projects, and to provide service in society, especially to those on the margins. **You will find the box throughout Lent in front of the lectern.**

### SCHOOLS/UNDER-5s

**CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE:** If your child is presently in year 5 and would wish to go to St Mary's or another Catholic secondary school in 2018, or if your child is looking to go into Reception year in a Catholic Primary school in autumn 2018, then you will need to apply **immediately** to go on the list for requesting a 'Certificate of Catholic Practice' towards the end of 2017. An information pack is **available now** from the presbytery. Once you have completed the form and returned it to the presbytery, your name will be added to the weekly sign-in-sheet which will be available in the church porch on the noticeboard (by the fire-exit door) for signing after the Saturday evening vigil Mass and the Masses of Sunday. On this basis Fr Philip will be in a better position to judge whether he can issue the Certificate you ask for.
