

THIS WEEKEND OUR FINAL 'LOVE IN ACTION' THEME on Catholic Social Teaching is 'Solidarity & Peace.' The Popes across the past century or more have pleaded for peace in the world, and the Second Vatican Council appealed in a similar way. We know how much devastation is caused by the absence of peace, and the presence of tension and armed conflict. Central to Catholic Social Teaching is the promotion of peace. May we begin to grow a culture of peace in our own lives, as Our Lord would want: "*Blessed are the peacemakers ...*"





Hopefully you have been engaged over the last few weeks with the importance of our Catholic Social Teaching, and the demand on ourselves to live well in our own situation this 'love in action.'

THE TRAGIC 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE ABORTION ACT took place last Friday (27th October) and the Bishops of England & Wales, and Scotland, marked this with a comprehensive statement, available here: <http://www.catholicnews.org.uk/Home/News/50-Years-of-the-Abortion-Act/Joint-Statement-on-Abortion>. Almost 8.9 million lives have been destroyed in this country over the past 50 years by abortion, an appalling statistic. Preparing for the Eucharistic Congress 2018: John Paul II's *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, n. 5:



The thought of [the Eucharist] leads us to profound amazement and gratitude. In the paschal event and the Eucharist which makes it present throughout the centuries, there is a truly enormous "capacity" which embraces all of history as the recipient of the grace of the redemption. This amazement should always fill the Church assembled for the celebration of the Eucharist. But in a special way it should fill the minister of the Eucharist. For it is he who, by the authority given him in the sacrament of priestly ordination, effects the consecration.
