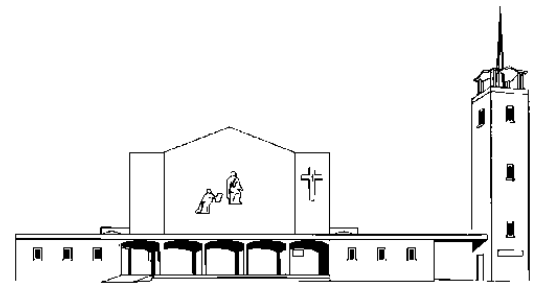

My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,

I'D LIKE TO DRAW YOUR ATTENTION TO THREE EVENTS coming up in our parish this autumn:

1. **Parish Party on Saturday 30th September:** as a way of marking my 10 years at St Augustine's (I began here on 1st October 2007) there'll be a parish party after Saturday evening Mass on 30th September. I really would love as many parishioners to be here as possible, and to come and celebrate this milestone with me. Fr Brian was here in Hoddesdon some 12yrs, so I haven't quite clocked up as many as him, ... nor anywhere near the 25yrs of Fr Tollemache!

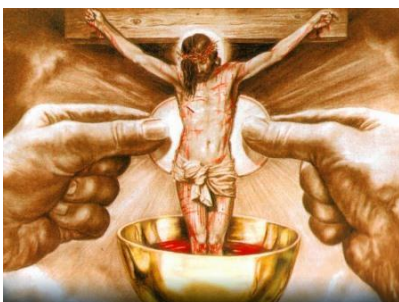
2. **RISE Theatre play about Oscar Romero, 17th October:** this is a very powerful production about the life and ministry of the martyred Archbishop of San Salvador, performed by the wonderful RISE Theatre, who have visited our parish several times before, most notably for a play about St Alban the other year. I have seen this play already, when it was launched in London in a church near Leicester Square, and can vouch for its being very moving. Tickets from the Presbytery (£10 each) and on sale after weekend Masses from next weekend.

3. **Parish Mission with John Pridmore, 27th-29th November:** we welcome a return visit from John Pridmore, the man whose life was turned round by the Lord from involvement in gangster-land crime and violence to a life committed to the spread of the Gospel. It's 3 years since he last came and led us in some days of Mission, and I am delighted that he has agreed to come back to our parish. Do keep these dates free in your diary!

IN A YEAR'S TIME (SEPT 7TH-9TH) WE WILL BE GOING TO THE EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS in Liverpool. By way of preparation for that, our quotations at the foot of the Newsletter's front page each week will be from a beautiful encyclical letter of Pope John Paul II, entitled *Ecclesia de Eucharistia* ("The Church from the Eucharist"). May our love for the Mass grow ever deeper!

Preparing for the Eucharistic Congress 2018: John Paul II's *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, n. 1:



The Church draws her life from the Eucharist. This truth does not simply express a daily experience of faith, but recapitulates *the heart of the mystery of the Church*. In a variety of ways she joyfully experiences the constant fulfilment of the promise: "Lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age," but in the Holy Eucharist, through the changing of bread and wine into the body and blood of the Lord, she rejoices in this presence with unique intensity. Ever since Pentecost, when the Church, the People of the New Covenant, began her pilgrim journey towards her heavenly homeland, the Divine Sacrament has continued to mark the passing of her days, filling them with confident hope.

TUESDAY LUNCH CLUB will resume on **12th September** 12.30-2.30pm in the crypt. Price £4. Anybody & everybody welcome!

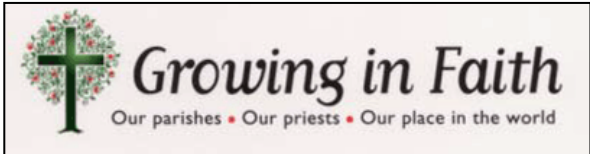
