

GOSPEL: Matthew 20: 1-16

Why be envious because I am generous?

My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,

'LOVE IN ACTION' IS THE NAME OF A PROGRAMME devised by Caritas Westminster, our diocesan agency for promoting the social good. We are going to be following this programme over the next couple of months, with a view to discerning what precise need there is in our local community here that would be best for us to address. We

begin by hearing over the course of the next 6 Sundays some of the Church's vast body of Social Teaching, divided into 6 themes. These were outlined on the red-and-white invitation card you received last week (spares by the Newsletters in the porch).

The first of these themes is 'Creation' – so I will do my best to present in the homily today the key aspects of our attitude as the People of God to our care for this beautiful world. As Pope Francis has said in his 2015 encyclical letter, *Laudato Si'*: "The earth and all it contains has been created by God. It is a gift, given to all for the good of all. And in the gift we experience something of the Giver – of the love of God." PLEASE DO NOT FORGET, COMING UP SOON:



Preparing for the Eucharistic Congress 2018: John Paul II's *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, n. 2:



During the Great Jubilee of the Year 2000 I had an opportunity to celebrate the Eucharist in the Cenacle of Jerusalem where, according to tradition, it was first celebrated by Jesus Himself. ... It is there that Christ took bread, broke it and gave it to His disciples, saying: "Take this, all of you, and eat it: this is My body which will be given up for you." Then He took the cup of wine and said to them: "Take this, all of you and drink from it: this is the cup of My blood, the blood of the new and everlasting covenant. It will be shed for you and for all, so that sins may be forgiven." I am grateful to the Lord Jesus for allowing me to repeat in that same place, in obedience to His command: "Do this in memory of Me," the words

which He spoke two thousand years ago.

CATECHETICS

CONFIRMATION 2018: The next session will be on the **3rd October at 7.15pm** in the crypt for candidates and parents. Candidates need to have read **chapter 3** of Mark's Gospel.

"**RCIA**" - 'Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults' is the programme for preparation for adults wishing to become Catholics, or be prepared for the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion). **The course continues on Monday, 25th September at 7pm.** If anyone is considering becoming a Catholic (or is an adult Catholic wishing to be confirmed,) please contact Fr Philip as soon as possible. Our fundraising began in 2014, and we have pledged of c. £185k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £51k. So far we already have £24k available for our parish project, which is to employ a part-time worker in the area of catechetics and evangelization.
