



GOSPEL: Luke 1: 26-38

*Listen! You are to conceive and bear a son.*

**My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,**

OUR PREPARATION SEASON OF ADVENT draws to its close this Fourth Sunday, and we hear in the Gospel the key event of the 'Annunciation' to Our Blessed Lady of the plan of God: to bring His Son into the world as her son. The Church Fathers often would make reference to the obedient faith of Mary, as she heard the "Ave" ("Hail!") of the Angel Gabriel, as undoing the disobedient sin of Eve when she succumbed, along with Adam, to the devil's lies. Hence in Latin the play on words ... *Eva / Ave* ... the one reverses the other. We see this portrayed beautifully in the image here on the right: Mary, bearing the divine Jesus in her womb, consoles bereft Eve in her sinful sadness, and crushes the head of the serpent under her foot. Eve acknowledges, as she venerates the child in Mary's womb, that her only salvation is in Him.



OUR PARISH CHRISTMAS MASSES are at the usual times, and I look forward to celebrating with you the sacred and festive day of Our Lord's birth:



**Preparing for the Eucharistic Congress 2018: John Paul II's *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, 11:**



The Church has received the Eucharist from Christ her Lord not as one gift — however precious — among so many others, but as *the gift par excellence*, for it is the gift of himself, of his person in his sacred humanity, as well as the gift of his saving work. Nor does it remain confined to the past, since "all that Christ is — all that he did and suffered for all men — participates in the divine eternity, and so transcends all times." When the Church celebrates the Eucharist, the memorial of her Lord's death and resurrection, this central event of salvation becomes really present and "the work of our redemption is carried out."

## CATECHETICS

**CONFIRMATION 2018:** The Enrolment Masses will be on the **6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> January 2018** and will involve a statement and promise of commitment to ongoing preparation. The next session will be on **Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> January 7.15pm** for candidates. Candidates will need to have read chapter 9 of the Gospel of Mark. The Confirmation Mass will be on **Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> April at 1.30pm.**

**"RCIA"** - 'Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults' is the programme for preparation for adults wishing to become Catholics, or be prepared for the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion). **The course continues on Mon 8<sup>th</sup> January 2018.**

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME:** Next meeting for parents is on **Wed 10<sup>th</sup> Jan 8-9pm** in the crypt. The fourth session for children will be on **Mon 15<sup>th</sup> Jan 6-7.30pm.**

**BAPTISM COURSE:** The next course will be held on **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> January 2018** 7.30-9pm in the presbytery. To enrol on the course, please contact the presbytery. The course must be completed before a Baptism can be arranged.



Our fundraising began in 2014, and **we have pledged of c. £185k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £51k.** So far we already have £24k available for our parish project, which is to employ a part-time worker in the area of catechetics and evangelization. Fr Philip is working with the diocese and seeking advice from other diocesan priests to draw up a job description to find the right person for this role.

## SCHOOLS/UNDER-5s

**CATHOLIC SCHOOLS:** Do you support Catholic schools and the right of Catholics to send their children to them? Then we need you to make your voice heard. The Government is making a critical decision on whether to overturn the admissions cap which prevents Catholic schools from allowing all Catholic pupils to attend. They have acknowledged that this policy discriminates against Catholics and promised to abandon it; now we need you to tell them not to U-turn on their promise to Catholics.
