

GOSPEL: John 17: 11-19

*That they may be one like us!*

**My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,**

**HAVING CELEBRATED THE ASCENSION ON THURSDAY**, we have the 7<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter restored to the calendar, this final Eastertide Sunday before Pentecost. We hear of the Apostles (in the first reading) choosing a new '12<sup>th</sup> Apostle' – Matthias – to replace Judas Iscariot, in those days after the Lord had ascended and before the coming of the Holy Spirit. And in the Gospel we hear powerful words from Jesus, praying for His Apostles that they be "consecrated in the truth": this is, in effect, their 'ordination' as His priests as they go out in His Name to give the life of the Gospel to the world!

**MAY IS THE MONTH OF MARY AND WE HAVE OUR MAY PROCESSION** in her honour **this Sunday**. We will begin, as usual, in the Lady Chapel at 5pm, and in procession we will recite the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary and have hymns and prayers of devotion to our heavenly Mother, ending at the garden Grotto – and afterwards have tea in the garden/conservatory. Please come and participate in this special Marian prayer for May, for all your intentions.


**THE NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS COMES UP IN SEPTEMBER**, AND I want to give some instruction on the Eucharist for the parish, partly through homilies, and partly through talks. This Tuesday I'll give the 1<sup>st</sup> of a series of 3 monthly talks exploring the sacred Jewish background to Our Lord's great new Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. This **Tuesday, 15<sup>th</sup> May at 8pm in church: "The Passover."**

**I THANK YOU FOR PATIENCE WITH REGARD TO THE CRYPT'S RE-FIT.** I know that it has been awkward having the Crypt kitchen out of action for 3 months, but we are nearing its completion. The new hallway flooring was covered by an insurance pay-out, but the work done on dealing with the damp problems, the electrics, and the now-ordered kitchen units and appliances needs to be paid for. We have sought to make sure that the work is done well, and that it is the best value for money, but the total cost comes to about £18k. We have already received a generous donation towards the new kitchen, but if any other parishioners wish to contribute to this cost, then it will be gratefully welcomed. We hope that the new kitchen will last us well into the future, which is important especially as the Tuesday Lunch Club expands, and we have our Winter-Night-Shelter contribution to consider.

**Preparing for the Eucharistic Congress 2018: John Paul II's *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, 27:**



The second sense in which the Church is apostolic, as the *Catechism* points out, is that "with the help of the Spirit dwelling in her, the Church keeps and hands on the teaching, the 'good deposit,' the salutary words she has heard from the Apostles." Here too the Eucharist is apostolic, for it is celebrated in conformity with the faith of the Apostles. At various times in the two-thousand-year history of the People of the New Covenant, the Church's Magisterium has more precisely defined her teaching on the Eucharist, including its proper terminology, precisely in order to safeguard the apostolic faith with regard to this sublime mystery. This faith remains unchanged and it is essential for the Church that it remain unchanged.
